Belief Statement:


DOLLS has adopted the Apostle's Creed as its statement of beliefs:

We close our devotionals by reading the prayer requests of our members. And finally, to conclude our meeting, the 5 Main return to the stage and discuss any business related to the club, including upcoming social events, volunteering opportunities, and ways the students can continue in their efforts to grow closer to God beyond involvement in this club.

Teenagers are at a very vulnerable time in their life. They find themselves at a pivotal point where they will make decisions that can forever impact the course of their life. DOLLS intends to help show these students the "right decisions", steering them clear of making negative ones, and serves to lead them down the path of righteousness.
